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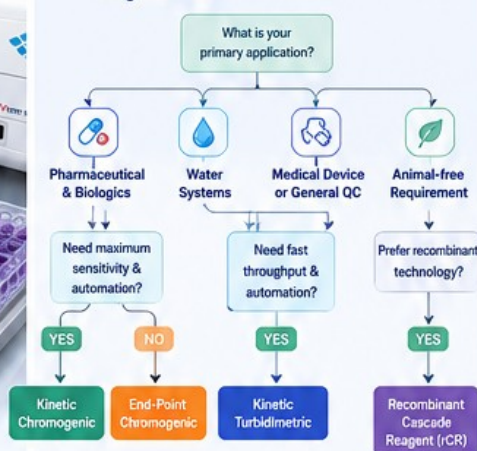

5 CASE STUDIES

Injectable Pharmaceutical

Challenge: Low endotoxin recovery in formulated product

Approach: Optimized dilution buffer, sample preparation and MVD

Outcome: Recovery improved from 35% to 98% within acceptance criteria

Monoclonal Antibody (Biologics)

Challenge: High matrix effect causing inhibition

Approach: Method suitability study using Kinetic Chromogenic with PPC

Outcome: Validated method with recovery 85–110% and excellent precision

Water for Injection

Challenge: Time-consuming manual endotoxin testing

Approach: Implemented Kinetic Turbidimetric method on automated system

Outcome: Testing time reduced by 60% with consistent results

Animal-free Facility

Challenge: Transition from LAL to animal-free technology

Approach: rCR method validation on Venus 96E Pro

Outcome: Validated successfully with improved lot-to-lot consistency

6 TECHNICAL TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Avoid contamination**
Use endotoxin-free consumables and aseptic technique
- Check pH**
Most LAL reagents perform best at pH 6.0 – 8.0
- Mind the matrix**
High protein, surfactants or chelators may inhibit or enhance results
- Validate regularly**
Revalidate when there are changes in formalization, process or method
- Use PPC effectively**
PPC is your best indicator of method reliability
- Review data critically**
Look for trends, curves and control performance
